

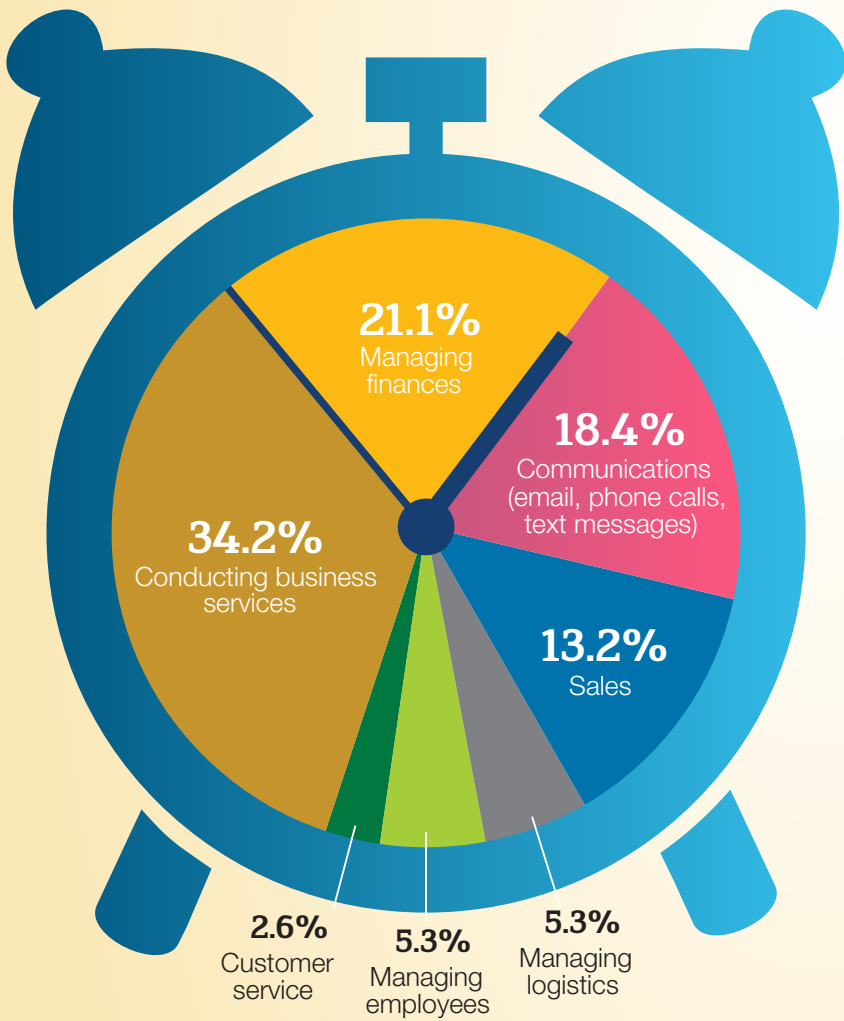
How Small Business Owners Spend Their Time

TOP OF THE TO-DO LIST

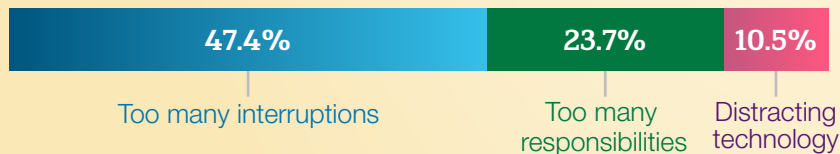

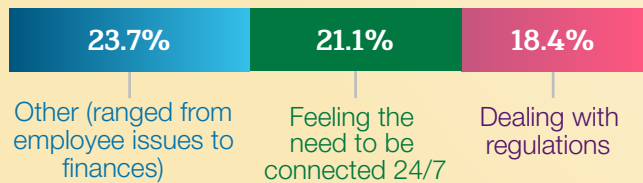
STRESS TEST

What prevents you from feeling productive at work?



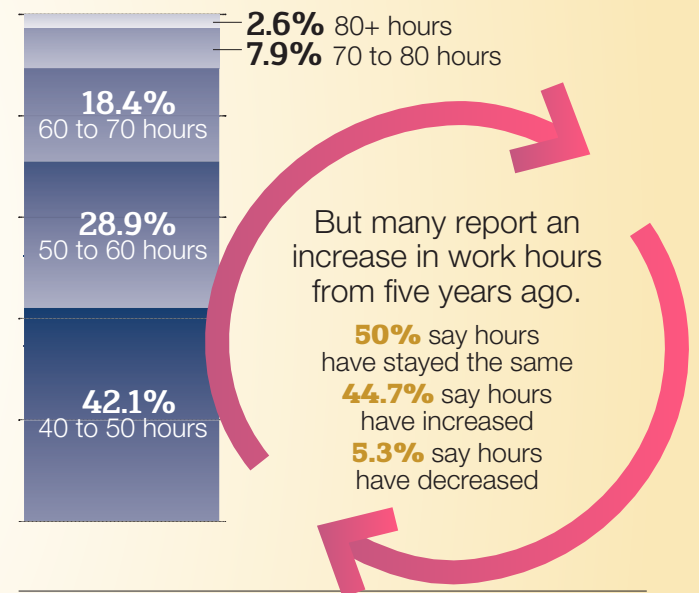
What is the biggest source of work-related stress?
